

Activities Update

In the coming years Greenhills will be joining other Uniting Venues around the country with a full scale Outdoor Recreation Department. The first steps in this journey are now coming to fruition with structures already built for initiative activities, such as "Vines" and "Spirit Level" (pictured below), and a 3-D "Spiders Web". Our Vertical Cluster is also on track, with plans to have it ready by mid-January.

Along with these high-intensity activities, we now offer a variety of low-intensity activities ranging from games for pure fun such as "Slime Time", Night Hikes through our wonderful bushland, "Clash of Clans" and other team building activities, "The Amazing Race" and, of course, our ever popular Campfire nights.
